# Day 1: Embracing God's Strength in Weakness

Day 1: ① Embracing God's Strength in Weakness

#### Devotional: God's Power Perfected in Our Weakness

**Feeling weak and weary is not a sign of failure.** For ministry leaders, admitting burnout or emotional struggle can feel vulnerable or even shameful. Yet, Paul's words in 2 Corinthians remind us that *God's power shines most brilliantly in our weakness*. Jesus invites the weary and burdened to find rest in Him. This rest is not just a break but a transformation of the inner self. It's a gentle, guiding, and strengthening kind of peace that recalibrates your entire being.

Jesus modeled daily withdrawal to quiet places to commune with the Father. These moments of solitude are crucial to renewing passion and vision so you can conquer spiritual heights, like a sure-footed deer.

If you feel your zeal dimming or your heart heavy, take time to be still before God. Quiet faith restores clarity and kindles fresh passion. Without this, it's easy to become frustrated, overwhelmed, or disconnected from your calling.

**Allow yourself to slow down and seek God's presence today.** He longs to empower your steps with confidence and peace.
