Devotional: The Impact of Encouragement on Vision

Encouragement is vital when your spouse pursues their God-given calling. Proverbs assures us that committing our plans to God results in their establishment. Your words and actions in encouraging your spouse become an extension of that divine commitment.

In ministry, work, or personal ambitions, your spouse needs to know they are not alone. Paul's letters remind us how critical it is to build one another up and spur each other on. Your encouragement might be a listening ear, a word of affirmation, a prayer, or practical support.

Supporting Scriptures

- Philippians 2:3 "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves."
- Colossians 3:12 "Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience."







Devotional: Humility: The Heart of Support

Supporting your spouse's calling with **humility** is essential because it reminds us to prioritize love over pride. Ephesians urges us to approach one another with gentleness and patience — qualities that create a safe and nurturing environment for growth.

In the partnership of marriage, humility is choosing to celebrate your spouse's successes without envy or competition. It means bearing one another's burdens and gently correcting with love rather than harshness.

Devotional: Serving Together in Love
