Devotional: Wisdom Starts with Reverence for God

Wisdom begins with reverence for God. Teaching children that respecting and trusting God is the starting point sets a firm foundation for their lives. Without this core understanding, true wisdom cannot flourish. The fear of the Lord is not a fear that paralyzes but one that motivates obedience, trust, and awe.

As adults, it's essential to instill this by word and example. Children absorb much from watching how we live out our faith. When they see our genuine respect and dependence on God, their hearts are more likely to embrace wisdom naturally.

Moreover, Scripture challenges us to be both humble learners and diligent teachers. Fools reject wisdom and correction, but children, in their formative years, have incredible potential to grow in understanding. Your role is to cultivate an environment where wisdom is prized and instruction is welcomed with love.

Remember, teaching wisdom is not just about imparting rules but guiding children toward a relationship with God that shapes their character and decisions for a lifetime.

Devotional: Daily Instruction Shapes Godly Character

Instruction is the practical cultivation of wisdom. Teaching wisdom is an ongoing journey—one that requires intentional daily choices to share God's truths and life lessons consistently. The Scriptures emphasize the vital role of parents and mentors taking responsibility for this charge.

From the earliest years, children need to hear, see, and experience godly instruction. This doesn't only mean formal teaching but demonstrating kindness, patience, justice, and love in everyday moments. It also means guiding them gently without provocation or harshness, which can hinder their growth.

Encourage young people to ask questions, wrestle with biblical truths, and understand why wisdom matters beyond simple obedience. When they understand the heart behind God's commands, wisdom becomes internalized rather than imposed.

As you mentor, remember every conversation and example matters. Your faithfulness in this task echoes into eternity, shaping character, choices, and the legacy passed forward.
