Introduction

Your own struggles, disappointments, or feelings of being unseen can be part of a bigger picture only God fully understands. **As you reflect on Joseph's journey, let it inspire you to trust God's timing and purposes in your life today.**

Each day in this study will focus on a different aspect of Joseph's story and how it applies to your life as a teen. You will gain encouragement, learn practical ways to navigate challenges, and discover how God can use every experience for good. Let's walk this journey together and discover the hope and purpose God has for you.





Day 1: ☉ Embracing the Pit: Finding God in Hard Places



Your Verse

Genesis 37:23-24 NIV - "So when Joseph came to his brothers, they stripped him of his robe—the ornate robe he was wearing—and they took him and threw him into the cistern..."

Supporting Scriptures

- *Psalm 34:18 - "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."*
- *Romans 8:28 - "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him..."*



Devotional: Trusting God in the Darkest Moments

Everyone faces moments that feel like a pit—dark, lonely, and painful. For Joseph, being thrown into the cistern by his own brothers was such a moment. As a teen, you might feel misunderstood, rejected, or stuck in circumstances beyond your control. Yet, God's presence is not far away, even when your situation looks bleak.

Psalm 34:18 reminds us that God is especially close to those who are brokenhearted. This is a powerful truth to hold onto. Joseph's pit was terrifying, but it was only the beginning of God's plan for him. Sometimes, the 'pits' in your life are places where God is preparing you for something greater.

When life tests you, remember: God is shaping your character and faith. Your current struggles are not the end. They can be the soil from which your purpose grows. Trust Him to be your comfort and guide through every hard season.



Reflect and Apply

1. What 'pits' or hard situations do you feel you're currently in?

2. How can knowing God is close to the brokenhearted change your perspective?

3. In what ways might this difficult time be preparing you for something bigger?



Journaling Prompts

1. Write about a difficult experience you have felt trapped in and how you saw (or wish you could see) God's hand during that time.

2. Describe what it means to you that God is close when you feel brokenhearted.

3. List three ways you can lean on God when facing challenges this week.

- *Philippians 1:6 – "He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion..."*

Devotional: God's Purpose Beyond Our Setbacks

Joseph's story encourages us that setbacks are not the end; they are part of God's purpose. Though his brothers meant harm by selling him into slavery, God used that situation to position Joseph as a key leader who saved lives during famine.

This teaches us that even when life's disappointments feel unfair, God can turn them into blessings. As a teen, you might face things that feel like dead ends—failure, rejection, mistakes. But God's plans are greater and often unfold in ways we don't expect.

Jeremiah 29:11 reminds us that God has good plans for your future. Whatever you are facing today, have confidence that God is not finished with you. He is working in and through your circumstances to prepare you for the incredible purpose He has designed uniquely for you.

Keep trusting, keep growing, and be open to how God can transform setbacks into opportunities for growth and blessing.



Reflect and Apply

1. Have you ever experienced a setback that later led to something good in your life?

2. How can Joseph's story help you view your challenges differently?

3. What promises from God give you hope for your future?



Journaling Prompts

1. Write about a time you faced disappointment and how God brought good from it, or how you believe He will.

2. List your hopes and dreams and pray asking God to guide you toward His purposes.

3. Reflect on God's promises for your life and write how they can strengthen you daily.
