## Your Verse

## Supporting Scriptures

- *Romans 12:6 – "We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us."*
- *Colossians 3:23 – "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord."*



## Day 1: ✨ Embracing Your God-Given Role

## Devotional: Recognizing and Using Your Gifts Now

God has uniquely gifted each of us, including teens, to serve in the body of Christ. 1 Peter reminds us that our gifts are not for selfish gain but to bless others as stewards of God's grace. You don't have to be 'older' or 'more experienced' to begin serving. Even small acts of service demonstrate God's love and faithfulness.

*Think about your talents and interests—maybe you enjoy helping younger kids, have musical ability, or feel comfortable with technology.* These are all valuable ways to serve. Colossians encourages us to work with all our hearts, emphasizing that serving God is not about age but about attitude.

## Your Verse

*Psalm 100:1-2 - "Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs."*

## Supporting Scriptures

- *1 Chronicles 15:16 - "David told the leaders to appoint their fellow Levites as musicians to make a joyful sound with musical instruments."*
- *Colossians 3:16 - "Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit."*



## Devotional: Joyful Worship as a Form of Service

**Many teens love music and worship—these are wonderful ways to serve God and the church community.** The Psalms remind us to worship with gladness and joyful songs. Music is a powerful vehicle to express our love for God and to encourage others in their faith.

*Just like David appointed musicians to lead worship with enthusiasm and skill, your involvement in music, whether singing or playing instruments, is a meaningful service.* You may also support worship teams by helping with the planning, sound, or tech elements connected to music ministry.

When you serve through your passion for worship, you create an environment where others meet God's presence. Colossians teaches that our worship through music can richly teach and encourage the church. Whatever your role, your joyful participation makes a difference. Serving through your talents draws you closer to God and strengthens the church family.

## Your Verse

## Supporting Scriptures

- *Galatians 6:9 – "Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up."*
- *Acts 6:3 – "Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom to serve."*



## Devotional: Shining Your Light with Outreach & Tech

**Serving at church also includes outreach and behind-the-scenes support like technology—both essential for the church’s mission.** Jesus encourages us to let our light shine through good deeds, impacting others by reflecting His love visibly.

*Whether you enjoy using your tech skills to help with sound, video, or online platforms or you feel called to outreach by sharing God’s love beyond church walls, your service matters greatly.* Galatians reminds us to keep doing good, even when it feels challenging, because God promises a harvest in due time. Acts shows the early church empowered people full of the Spirit and wisdom to serve important roles.

Today, consider how your passions for outreach or technology can be a beacon in your church and community. Serving in these areas allows you to participate fully in God’s work and helps build a welcoming, connected church environment. Your service shines God’s light and draws many closer to Him.

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3. How does serving behind the scenes reflect God's glory just as much as front-line service?
