Psalm 34:1 – I will extol the Lord at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
- Deuteronomy 6:5 Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.







Devotional: Seeing God in Everyday Moments

God's presence in your daily life is often more visible when you pause and acknowledge Him. Sometimes teens feel their life is too normal or uneventful to share, but God works in both big moments and quiet routines. Psalm 34:1 reminds us to praise God at all times, which helps us see His hand guiding us even when things seem ordinary.

When you intentionally thank God each day, like 1 Thessalonians 5:18 advises, you begin to notice His blessings and faithfulness. It might be in a kind word from a friend, strength during a tough test, or peace in a stressful moment. These moments are part of your testimony.

Remember Deuteronomy 6:5, which calls you to love God with your whole heart. Your love for Him helps you recognize His activity in your life and lays a strong foundation for sharing that story with others.

Today, focus on becoming aware of the ways God has been present and faithful in your everyday life. No experience is too small to remember.

Supporting Scriptures

- Revelation 12:11 They triumphed over him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony.
- John 9:25 One thing I do know. I was blind but now I see!







Devotional: The Power of Sharing Your Hope

Your testimony is powerful because it shows what God has done uniquely in your life. 1 Peter 3:15 encourages us to be ready to share the reason for our hope — that hope comes from personal encounters with God and the story He is writing through you.

The Bible tells us in Revelation 12:11 that believers overcome struggles through the "word of their testimony." This means your story, no matter how ordinary you think it is, has authority and power when you share it with faith.

Consider the story of the man healed in John 9:25. His simple statement, "I was blind but now I see!" is a bold and clear testimony of God's power that continues to inspire.

Don't be discouraged if your story doesn't seem dramatic — your honesty and faithfulness matter most. Your real experience with God is a beacon of hope and can encourage others who are searching or hurting.
