Devotional: God's Presence Moves with Purpose

Though the text doesn't list his faith explicitly, the household welcomed the Ark and God's presence without fear or hesitation. The result was a blessing: "The LORD blessed Obed-Edom and all his household" (2 Samuel 6:11).

This story highlights the significance of hospitality toward God's presence. When we intentionally open our hearts and homes to God, He promises to bring blessing and favor. Obed-Edom's household became a testament to God's faithfulness and generosity toward those who honor Him.

Consider how your heart and home are prepared to receive God today. Hospitality toward God can be more than welcoming people – it involves inviting God Himself to reside within us.

Devotional: The Necessity of Reverence and Obedience

Their disobedience cost them their lives, teaching Israel—and us—that God's standards are perfect and non-negotiable.

Reverence means more than fear—it means honor, trust, and obedience that acknowledge God's supreme holiness. It safeguards our relationship with Him and allows His blessings to flow unhindered.
