Proverbs 10:9 NIV – "Whoever walks in integrity walks securely, but whoever takes crooked paths will be found out."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 25:21 "May integrity and uprightness protect me, because my hope, Lord, is in you."
- Job 27:5 "I will never admit you are in the right; till I die, I will not deny my integrity."







Devotional: Walking Securely Through Integrity

Integrity is the foundation upon which a secure life is built. Proverbs 10:9 vividly contrasts two paths: one marked by integrity and security, the other by crookedness and exposure. Walking in integrity means living transparently and honestly, aligning our actions with God's truth consistently. This secures not only our spiritual standing but our peace of mind.

Psalm 25:21 encourages us that integrity and uprightness provide divine protection. When we root our lives in honesty and faithfulness, we invite God's safeguarding presence. Even in trials, a clear conscience empowers us to stand firm like Job, who declared that he would never deny his integrity.

Day 2: V Integrity Builds Trust









Your Verse

Proverbs 11:3 NIV – "The integrity of the upright guides them, but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 15:1-2 "Lord, who may dwell in your sacred tent? Anyone who walks blamelessly and does what is righteous."
- 2 Corinthians 8:21 "For we are taking pains to do what is right, not only in the eyes of the Lord but also in the eyes of man."







Devotional: Building Trust Through Upright Living

Integrity is essential in building trust with God and others. Proverbs 11:3 reminds us that uprightness provides guidance, forming the bedrock for reliable, trustworthy character. When we are faithful in what is right, people and God can depend on us.

Psalm 15 describes the one who may dwell with the Lord as blameless and righteous, highlighting how living without deceit opens the door to fellowship with God. Similarly, Paul in 2 Corinthians 8:21 emphasizes carefully doing what is right not just before God but also in the eyes of others.
