#### Devotional: The Foundation of True Honor

- Romans 12:10: "Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves."







#### Devotional: Humility: The Path to Peace

**Humility is key to fostering unity and peace.** Paul's letters to the early churches emphasize how living in humility leads to love and patience among believers. In Ephesians 4:2, humility is paired with gentleness and patience, crucial qualities for sustaining unity.
