
# The Courage of David: Strength in Faith

#### Devotional: Faith Over Fear: Facing Life's Giants

David's confrontation with Goliath is one of the most iconic demonstrations of courage in the Bible. This bold declaration reveals a key aspect of spiritual courage—it is grounded in faith, not in our abilities or weapons.

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

#### Your Verse

#### Devotional: Mercy Is Courage Under Pressure

David's courage wasn't just physical bravery; it was a steadfast inner strength to do what was right even under intense pressure. When he had the chance to harm King Saul—his pursuer—David chose mercy and respected God's authority.

This story highlights a courageous heart that respects God's timing and justice, instead of retaliating in our own way. Courage often means holding our tongue, trusting that God will act on our behalf, and resisting the temptation to take matters into our own hands.

**True courage is found in obedience and patience.** It requires faith that God's plans are better than ours, even when circumstances seem unfair or frightening. When pressured, will you trust God's justice or take shortcuts?




















Day 3: **5** Courage Through Worship

#### Devotional: Worship: The Courage Booster

Music and worship were central to David's expression of courage. After surviving countless life-threatening experiences, he lifted songs of praise that celebrated God's protection and deliverance. Worship can be a powerful source of courage—it realigns our focus from fear toward faith.

When we praise God, we declare His sovereignty over our lives and acknowledge that He is our refuge. It shifts our hearts and minds, strengthening us to face tough moments with confidence and peace. Courage grows abundantly in those who worship even amidst adversity.

**Consider how worship fuels your courage.** Can you turn your fears into prayers and your doubts into songs?


