Devotional: Holding Firm to God's Unfailing Promises

Devotional: Trusting God's Presence in Hard Times

Life as a teen can be tough, and trials often come unexpectedly. But Psalm 34:17–18 gives a powerful reminder: God is near when you're hurting. His faithfulness means He listens to your cries and offers comfort and rescue, even when you feel broken or alone.

Many teens wrestle with anxiety, loneliness, or pressures that overwhelm them. In these moments, trust that God is not distant or uncaring. Romans 8:28 encourages us with the truth that God works everything out for good—even hard struggles. His faithfulness includes using difficulties to shape and strengthen you.

How does knowing God is close to the brokenhearted impact your view of your own challenges? Holding tightly to that truth provides hope and courage to face each day with confidence that God is working in your life for a purpose.
