#### Your Verse

Psalm 99:1 - The LORD reigns, let the nations tremble; he sits enthroned between the cherubim, let the earth shake.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 6:3 'Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory.'
- Revelation 4:8 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come.'

#### Devotional: The Majesty of God's Holy Throne

God's holiness commands awe and reverence. Psalm 99 opens by affirming the LORD's reign, emphasizing His sovereign authority over all nations. This reign is not passive; it causes the earth to shake and people to tremble. The imagery of God enthroned between the cherubim highlights His divine majesty and purity, separated from sin and imperfection.

Psalm 99:4 - The King is mighty, he loves justice— you have established equity; in Jacob you have done what is just and right.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Micah 6:8 '...to act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.'
- Exodus 34:6 'The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness.'







#### Devotional: Living Out God's Justice and Mercy

The holiness of God is inseparable from His justice and mercy. Psalm 99:4 celebrates God's loving commitment to justice and equity, a reflection of His perfect character. His holy nature does not tolerate injustice, yet it is paired with deep compassion and faithfulness to His people.

This balance reminds us that God's dealings with humanity are rooted in both righteousness and grace. He holds us accountable but also offers mercy — a holy justice that heals and restores rather than condemns unjustly.

#### Your Verse

Psalm 99:9 - Exalt the LORD our God and worship at his holy mountain, for the LORD our God is holy.

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- John 4:24 'God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.'
- Hebrews 12:28 'Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe.'







#### Devotional: Worshiping in Spirit and Truth

Worshiping a holy God requires heart, spirit, and truth. Psalm 99 concludes with a joyful call to exalt and worship the LORD at His holy mountain. His holiness is the central reason for worship — it shapes our attitude and approach.
