In this 3-day study, you will dive deep into Scripture to explore what the kingdom of God means from the perspective of Jesus' life and message. You'll discover the joy that comes from giving up lesser things for the surpassing worth of Christ, the cost and reward of discipleship, and how to live as a treasure-honoring follower today.

Let this study inspire you to see the hidden treasure in your own life—Jesus Himself—whose kingdom is greater than anything else you could gain. May you find deep joy in surrender, courage in sacrifice, and hope in the eternal promise God offers. *Open your heart, and be ready to receive the kingdom.*

Matthew 13:44 - "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field."

Supporting Scriptures

- Proverbs 2:4–5 "If you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the LORD..."
- Psalm 119:72 "The law from your mouth is more precious to me than thousands of pieces of silver and gold."

Devotional: The Joy of Finding God's Priceless Treasure

The parable of the hidden treasure reminds us how invaluable the kingdom of heaven is. Jesus compares the kingdom to a treasure found unexpectedly in a field, a discovery so valuable that the man joyfully gives up everything else to gain it. This teaches us that the kingdom is worth losing all else for—our comfort, possessions, and even our plans.

Many of us spend our lives chasing lesser treasures—wealth, status, or fleeting pleasures. But when we truly grasp the incomparable worth of God's kingdom, our priorities change. As Proverbs 2:4–5 encourages, we should seek the kingdom like hidden treasure, with determination and reverence.

The joy in the man's response also invites us to consider the attitude we bring. Finding the kingdom isn't a burden but a delight—something that fills our hearts with gladness and purpose. It's not just about gaining a prize but entering into a relationship with Christ, who embodies this treasure.

Today, reflect on what treasures you may be holding too tightly and how you can begin to pursue God's kingdom above all else.

Day 2: The Cost and Reward of Discipleship

Your Verse

Luke 14:27–33 – "Whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple... In the same way, those of you who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples."

Supporting Scriptures

- Matthew 16:24 "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."
- Philippians 3:7–8 "Whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ."







Day 2: The Cost and Reward of Discipleship

Devotional: Counting the Cost to Gain the Kingdom

Following Jesus means embracing both the cost and the reward of discipleship. In Luke 14, Jesus makes it clear that to be His disciple requires carrying a cross—which symbolizes sacrifice, self-denial, and sometimes suffering. This echoes the idea in Matthew 13:44 that the kingdom is precious enough to give up everything.

Discipleship is not easy; it calls us to evaluate what in our lives might be obstacles to fully following Christ. This could mean surrendering ambitions, security, or relationships if they don't align with God's will. Yet the reward is immeasurable: intimacy with God, peace beyond understanding, and eternal life.

Paul's words in Philippians remind us that what the world counts as gain pales compared to the surpassing worth of knowing Christ. He counted all else as loss to gain the fullness of God's grace and purpose.

Today, consider the costs you are willing — or not willing — to bear in your journey of faith. Let God help you see that true gain comes through loss in Him.

- Colossians 3:1–2 "Set your hearts on things above, not on earthly things."







Devotional: Shining as Treasures in God's Kingdom

Having found the hidden treasure, Christians are called to live as reflections of God's kingdom. 1 Peter 2:9 declares believers a chosen people and God's special possession, entrusted to shine His light in the world. When we embrace the kingdom, our lives become treasures that reveal God's glory.

Jesus calls His followers to be salt and light—visible, impactful, and transformative. Like a city on a hill, our faith is meant to stand out and point others toward hope and truth. This challenges us to live with integrity, love, and holiness as evidence of the treasure within us.

Paul's encouragement in Colossians reminds us to focus on heavenly things, not getting distracted by temporary earthly concerns. This heavenly perspective fuels joy and steadfastness in daily living, helping us honor the kingdom's invaluable worth.
