Devotional: Walking by the Light of God's Word

Letting God's Word Illuminate Our Way

Psalm 119:105 is one of the most beloved verses in Scripture because it beautifully captures the guiding purpose of God's Word. When life feels confusing or dark, the Bible acts as a lamp—casting light ahead so that we can walk in clarity and confidence.
