#### Devotional: His Return: A Promise of Hope

#### Devotional: The Peace Christ's Return Secures

#### **Peace Beyond Present Problems**

Isaiah's prophetic words about the coming Messiah reveal He is the "Prince of Peace." This peace transcends any earthly calm or relief—it is eternal and unshakeable. Jesus, through His return, will fully establish justice and wipe away every sorrow.

John 16:33 reassures believers that despite the troubles we face, Jesus has overcome the world. His coming signals the end of suffering, despair, and pain, as Revelation 21:4 promises a world restored with no more tears or death.

### Devotional: Christ's Justice Will Set All Right

#### Justice Perfected at His Return

The return of Jesus Christ is not only about hope and peace but also the execution of perfect justice. Revelation 19 paints a vivid picture of Christ as the righteous judge who will make wrongs right and defeat evil once and for all.

Unlike human justice, which is often flawed or partial, God's justice is flawless, equitable, and compassionate. Psalm 96 reassures us that all peoples will be judged fairly by the coming King.

While God's wrath against sin is real, His justice is also a source of deliverance for believers who have trusted in His mercy. Understanding this should motivate us to live holy lives and place our full hope in the fairness and sovereignty of Christ's return.

#### Your Verse

1 Thessalonians 5:5 - "You are all children of the light and children of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Ephesians 5:8 "For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord."
- Matthew 24:44 "You also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect Him."







Day 4: V Living as Children of Light

#### Devotional: Ready and Radiant in the Light

#### Walking in the Light While Awaiting Christ

The expectation of Christ's return calls believers to live as children of light—reflecting God's truth, purity, and love in a world often shadowed by darkness. Paul reminds the Thessalonians that they belong to the day and must live as such, prepared and alert.

Ephesians reiterates this transformation from darkness to light, calling all believers to live in a manner worthy of their new identity. Jesus' warning in Matthew encourages vigilance and readiness, emphasizing that we never know the exact time of His coming.

This truth encourages us to consistently examine our lives and make conscious choices that reflect our hope and readiness, becoming beacons of light and hope to others.

#### Devotional: Enduring with Joyful Patience

#### Devotional: Hope in the New Heaven and Earth
