Devotional: Honoring God's Past Faithfulness Together

Remembering God's faithfulness fuels hope and strengthens family legacy. Psalm 77:11 shows the power in recalling God's mighty acts and miracles as a source of courage and trust.

Joel calls for heartfelt return to God, often motivated by remembering His goodness even in hard times. Isaiah declares God's uniqueness, encouraging us to hold onto His promises as we teach the next generation. Family traditions that honor remembrance—through storytelling, memorials, or celebrations—anchor faith in history and hope.

Consider how your family can intentionally remember and recount God's work. This practice nurtures resilience and helps children see God's hand in their own lives and the lives of their ancestors.
