- Lamentations 3:22–23 Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.







#### Devotional: Knowing God's Tender Forgiveness

The opening verse of Psalm 103 unfolds the heart of God—compassionate, gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in love. This description is not just poetic praise; it reveals God's very character toward His people. Compassion means God moves toward us in our brokenness, not away from it. He understands our weakness and is patient with our failings.

His grace flows powerfully alongside compassion, offering unmerited favor and forgiveness. When we reflect on God's patience, it challenges us to reconsider how we respond to others and ourselves. His abounding love means His mercy is overflowing, never running dry no matter how often we stumble.

Today, embrace the reality that God's compassion is available to you always, making room for your mistakes and loving you deeply. This truth should lead us to worship and inspire us to live lives marked by forgiveness and kindness toward others.

- Lamentations 3:31–33 For no one is cast off by the Lord forever. Though he brings grief, he will show compassion, so great is his unfailing love.







#### Devotional: Living in the Assurance of God's Love

The psalmist marvels at God's boundless love and mercy, comparing it to the vastness of the heavens. This image encourages awe and trust—no matter the challenges or sins we face, God's love for His people remains unshakeable.

His mercy is everlasting, continually drawing us back despite our shortcomings and pain. Fear of the Lord here means deep reverence and trust, which opens us to fully experiencing this great love. It is this steadfast love that sustains us daily, resonates in our worship, and spurs us on to faithfulness.

As we close this study, let us hold tightly to God's promise of unfailing love and mercy. May it fill our hearts with peace and compel us to live rooted in gratitude and hope, sharing compassion generously with the world around us.
