Prayer for Today



Devotional: Embrace Healing Through Forgiveness

Supporting Scriptures

- Lamentations 3:22–23 "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."
- Ephesians 2:4 "But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved."







Devotional: Rest in God's Compassionate Love

God's compassion is the essence of His unfailing love. Psalm 103:8 beautifully describes God as compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and full of steadfast love.

- Romans 8:38–39 "For I am convinced that neither death nor life... will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

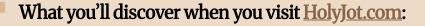




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
