# The Magi's Journey: Worship Through Wise Seeking

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#### Introduction

Throughout these 21 days, we will walk alongside the Magi spiritually, examining each step of their journey. We reflect on the nature of divine revelation, the joy and trials that accompany faithful obedience, and the ways we too are called to honor Christ with our gifts — whether talents, time, treasures, or transformation.

Each day will feature a primary Scripture passage with supporting verses, a devotional exploring the Magi's journey or themes connected to their worship, reflection questions to deepen your engagement, journaling prompts to capture your insights, and prayers to connect your heart with God's. Prepare to be inspired to seek Jesus earnestly, worship Him sincerely,







and share His light wherever you go. Let's begin this wondrous journey together!









Day 1: 🗱 The Star Appears









#### Your Verse

Matthew 2:1-2 - "After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked, 'Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

#### Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 60:1 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you."
- Psalm 19:1 "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands."







## Devotional: Recognizing God's Light and Answering the Call

The appearance of a mysterious star sparked curiosity and hope in the hearts of the Magi. These wise men observed the heavens and discerned a divine sign — the birth of a king worthy of worship. Their story reminds us that God often reveals Himself in unexpected ways, inviting us into an active seeking of His presence.

The Magi's response was immediate action — they left behind familiarity and comfort to pursue the truth behind the star. Such faith-driven steps require attentiveness to God's voice and readiness to trust beyond what is seen.

Like the Magi, our spiritual journey begins when we notice God's light shining in our lives, calling us to investigate more deeply. How will we respond to God's signs amid the noise of everyday life? Will we choose to rise up and follow the Light?

Day 2: The King Born in Bethlehem

#### Devotional: Embracing the Humble Majesty of Jesus

The prophecy in Micah points directly to Bethlehem, a humble town destined to birth the King of kings. This revelation gave the Magi hopeful certainty amid their long journey. God's plan was unfolding exactly as promised, in God's perfect timing and place.

The King they sought was not a ruler surrounded by grandeur but one born in simplicity and vulnerability — wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger. This contrast challenges us to rethink power, majesty, and greatness.

Like the Magi, we must look beyond external status to recognize Jesus' true identity and worth. Our worship too may involve setting aside preconceived notions and embracing God's unexpected ways. The same King who rules all creation chose to enter our world in humility, inviting us to receive Him with awe and gratitude.

# Devotional: Walking Faithfully Without Knowing the Destination

The Magi's journey was not a simple stroll; it was a bold walk of faith into the unknown. They relied on divine guidance, trusting the star and God's revelation even when the path was unclear. Their perseverance reminds us that faith often looks like steady steps forward, not full certainty.

Similarly, Abraham's obedience model shows us the beauty of trusting God's promises without having the full picture. The Magi exemplify this trust as they leave familiar grounds towards an unfamiliar destination — motivated by the desire to worship the newborn King.

Our faith journey calls us to hold loosely to plans and control, embracing God's leading with resolve. Sometimes the journey itself strengthens our worship and relationship with God as much as the destination.

The Magi's visit was a spiritual fulfillment of these ancient words — the moment when prophecy became history. Their worship acknowledged Jesus not only as a newborn but as the promised Messiah whose identity and mission transcended time.
