This contrast teaches us that persistence in prayer appeals to a God whose heart is full of justice and mercy. He is attentive to the cries of the oppressed and those who seek Him earnestly. Unlike the unjust judge, God's response is rooted in perfect love and righteousness.

Our persistence in prayer is powerful because it reaches the heart of a God who cares deeply, even when answers don't come immediately. Knowing God's justice motivates us to continue praying and trusting that He will act on our behalf in His perfect way and time.
