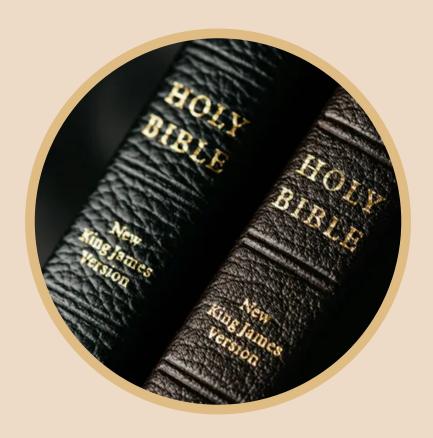

Prayer for Today

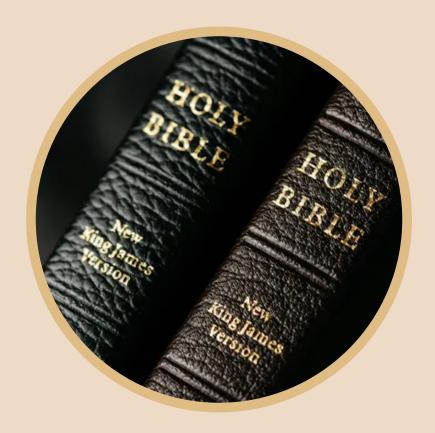

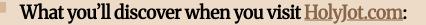
