'It is a simple matter for the shadow to go forward ten steps,' said Hezekiah. 'Instead, let it go back ten steps.' Then the prophet Isaiah called on the LORD, and the LORD made the shadow go back ten steps on the stairway of Ahaz."

Devotional: God's Authority Over Time and Circumstance
