#### Your Verse

Matthew 18:12—14 - "What do you think? If a man owns a hundred sheep, and one of them wanders away, will he not leave the ninety-nine on the hills and go to look for the one that wandered off?"

- Luke 15:4 "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it?"
- John 10:27–28 "My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish..."







#### Devotional: God's Relentless Heart for the One

Jesus' parable of the lost sheep powerfully reveals the tender heart of our Shepherd. Imagine a shepherd leaving the comfort and safety of ninety-nine sheep to venture into unknown danger in pursuit of just one lost sheep. This speaks volumes about the intrinsic value God places on every individual soul. The Shepherd's priority isn't the crowd or the majority, but the one who has gone astray.

In our lives, it's easy to overlook or get discouraged by one person who is lost or far from God. - Zephaniah 3:17 "The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing."

## Devotional: Living Out the Shepherd's Compassion
