#### Your Verse

Psalm 103:3 - "who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases,"

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Isaiah 1:18 "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool."
- 1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."







#### Devotional: God's Love Heals and Forgives Completely

Day 1 centers on the incredible forgiveness of God as declared in Psalm 103:3. This verse reminds us that God doesn't only forgive—He heals every part of us. Our sins, which separate us from Him and burden our hearts, are completely wiped away through His grace.

Think about how often you carry guilt or shame. God invites us to bring those burdens to Him, knowing He is ready to forgive and heal. Forgiveness is an expression of His strength and love; it's not weak or conditional but abundant and renewing.

Isaiah 1:18 paints a vivid picture of God's cleansing power—a transformation from scarlet stains of sin to purity as white as snow. This shows how comprehensive and thorough God's forgiveness is. In 1 John 1:9, we find a promise: confession leads to cleansing and restoration. This assures us that no matter what we've done, God's strength is enough to restore us fully.

#### Your Verse

Psalm 103:8 - "The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Lamentations 3:22–23 "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."
- Ephesians 2:4-5 "But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved."







Day 2: BEmbracing God's Compassion

#### Devotional: God's Compassion is a New Gift Each Morning

**Today, we focus on God's compassion and patience.** Psalm 103:8 reveals a God who is not quick to anger but abundantly loving and gracious. This characteristic is vital for us to grasp because it shows the nature of God's love toward imperfect people like you and me.

Life can be difficult, filled with moments where we fail or feel unworthy. Yet, God's compassion never runs dry. As Lamentations 3:22–23 reminds us, His mercies are new every morning, and His faithfulness is great. We can wake every day refreshed by His sustaining love.

In Ephesians 2:4–5, Paul emphasizes that God's mercy is so rich that He made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in our sins. This grace invites us not only to receive His love but to extend it to others, reflecting the compassionate heart of God.

- Romans 8:38–39 "For I am convinced that neither death nor life... will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."
- Jeremiah 31:3 "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness."







#### Devotional: God's Love Endures Through Every Generation

On our final day, we anchor ourselves in the eternal love of God. Psalm 103:17 assures us that God's love spans from everlasting to everlasting. This love is not fleeting or temporary but a firm foundation upon which our lives stand.

Paul's words in Romans 8:38–39 echo this truth, affirming that nothing in all creation can separate us from the love of God—not even death or life's hardships. This knowledge strengthens believers against fear, doubt, and insecurity because God's love surrounds and protects us always.

Jeremiah 31:3 beautifully describes God's love as everlasting and drawing us in with kindness. This love empowers us to live confidently, knowing we are cherished and upheld across generations.

Reflect on how God's everlasting love can give you strength for today and the future.
