

Devotional: Joyfully Embracing the Hidden Treasure


Prayer for Today

Devotional: Embracing the Joyful Cost of Discipleship

Jesus does not minimize the cost of discipleship. Following Him requires a radical surrender of all personal claims and comfort. Yet, the remarkable truth is that this cost leads to incomparable joy and true life.

Luke 14:33 clarifies that without surrendering everything, we cannot truly be His disciples. This surrender is not a grim burden but a joyous liberating choice. It frees us from the entanglements of self-importance, fear, and fleeting attachments to embrace God's best.

The paradox is stunning: losing our life in surrender results in finding abundant life in Christ. This leads to a peace and joy that the world cannot offer or understand. The man in Matthew 13 sold all to secure treasure; likewise, our surrender opens the door to eternal treasure and joy.

Today, reflect on where hesitation lies in fully surrendering to Jesus. Trust that the joy and rewards awaiting you far exceed the cost.
