Devotional: Why a Good Name Outweighs Riches

The Bible begins by highlighting the incomparable worth of a good reputation. Proverbs 22:1 draws a clear comparison between a good name and material wealth, asserting that a good reputation carries deeper and longer-lasting value than riches. Why? Because wealth can disappear, but a good name builds trust and cultivates lasting relationships.

Psalm 112 expands on this by linking a good reputation to reverence for God and obedience to His commands. When we align our lives with God's ways, our character shines through, earning genuine esteem. In a world where shortcuts and compromises to gain favor are tempting, maintaining integrity requires intentionality and courage.

Living with a good reputation means acting in ways that honor God both publicly and privately. It's about walking with honesty, kindness, and faithfulness, even when no one is looking. 1 Peter 3:16 reminds us that our conduct serves as a testimony, inviting others to respect Christ through us, while silencing critics.

Devotional: Walking Securely Through Integrity
