1 Corinthians 7:32–34 – "I would like you to be free from concern. An unmarried man is concerned about the Lord's affairs—how he can please the Lord."

#### Devotional: Discover Freedom in Your Unique Calling

God has uniquely created you with intentionality and purpose—singleness included. In 1 Corinthians, Paul encourages single believers to embrace their calling without distraction, focusing their heart wholly on God. This freedom offers a unique chance to develop intimacy with Him and pour into His kingdom.

It can be tempting to compare your life to others or to feel incomplete because you are single. However, Psalm 139 reminds us that you are "fearfully and wonderfully made" by a God who delights in every detail of your life. Your identity is not defined by your relationship status but by your standing in Christ.

Reflect on this: How might God be inviting you to use this season as a special time for growth and service? Embracing your unique calling empowers you to live confidently and passionately for the Lord.

#### Devotional: Choosing Joy and Contentment in Christ

Contentment is a powerful posture for the single believer. Paul's words in Philippians teach us that joy and peace come not from our circumstances, but from reliance on Christ's strength. Singleness might come with challenges, but it can also be a time rich with joy when rooted in God.

Many feel pressure to find happiness only through romantic relationships or societal markers. Yet, Scripture calls us to find our satisfaction fully in God's presence. Ask yourself: What areas of discontent might God be inviting you to surrender today? Choosing joy and contentment empowers us to serve and love others wholeheartedly.
