True Love in Teen Life



Explore 1 Corinthians 13's definition of love and learn how true love is patient, kind, and selfless, busting teen myths from movies and culture.





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Introduction

Welcome to this 3-day Bible study on true love for teens! In a world saturated with romantic movies, social media posts, and pop culture, the idea of love can often seem confusing or misleading. Many teens are presented with images of love that are based on instant attraction, dramatic gestures, or selfish desires. But what does God's Word say about love? How does His definition differ from the myths we often hear?

In this study, we will dive into *1 Corinthians 13*, often called the "love chapter," to discover what true love really looks like. This love is patient, kind, doesn't envy or boast, and is not proud or selfish. It is a love that puts others first and endures through challenges. This is the kind of love that transforms relationships — not just romantic ones, but friendships, family, and even how you treat yourself.

As a teen, this can be a powerful truth to hold onto. You don't have to settle for the "love" that movies portray or what social media glorifies. True love is deeper and more meaningful. It's rooted in God's example and His endless grace.

Over the next three days, you'll read scriptures, reflect deeply, journal your thoughts, and pray for God's guidance in how you understand and live out true love. Let's bust some myths and embrace the beautiful, selfless love God calls us to!

1 Corinthians 13:4 – "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud."

Supporting Scriptures

- John 15:12 "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you."
- Romans 12:9 "Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good."







Devotional: Understanding the Heart of True Love

True love starts with understanding what God's Word teaches. In 1 Corinthians 13:4, Paul paints a picture of love that is patient and kind. These qualities may seem simple, but they are powerful when lived out.

Patience means not rushing or forcing others to meet your expectations. As a teen, it can be tempting to want instant results in relationships or to grow frustrated quickly. But true love waits and supports growth.

Kindness is more than being nice — it's actively showing care, compassion, and respect. Movies may show love coming with drama or jealousy, but God's love is free of envy and pride. It's selfless and humble.

Think about your current friendships or crushes. Are patience and kindness guiding your actions towards others? Or are impatience and selfishness getting in the way? Remember, true love reflects God's love for us, and that love can transform how you relate to the people around you.

Day 2: 💸 Love That Goes Beyond Feelings

Devotional: Love Is More Than Feelings and Forgives

Love is more than just a feeling or momentary attraction. Today, Paul reminds us that true love does not dishonor others or act selfishly. This means real love respects people's worth and choices, even when feelings are complicated.

It's easy to get angry or hold grudges when hurt or rejected, especially during teen years filled with emotional ups and downs. But God's love calls us to patience and forgiveness, which prevent bitterness from taking root.

True love chooses to forgive and forget offenses, not keeping score or holding onto past mistakes. This selfless love reflects God's grace toward us, allowing relationships to heal and grow.

As you think about your friendships and family, where can you choose forgiveness over anger? Moving beyond feelings to act in love is a powerful way to live out God's truth and experience deeper peace.

- Galatians 5:13 "Serve one another humbly in love."







Devotional: Living Out Selfless Love Daily

True love is an active choice to serve and support others selflessly. Paul reminds us that love rejoices in truth and protects those we care about. It trusts, hopes, and perseveres even when things are hard.

In teen life, selfless love means putting others' needs before your own desires. It might look like supporting a friend during a tough time, standing up for someone being treated unfairly, or showing kindness without expecting anything in return.

Selfishness often tempts us because it feels easier or more comfortable. But God's love calls you to a higher standard—a love that perseveres, protects, and brings hope.

As you think about the relationships in your life, consider how you can practice selfless love daily. This is the kind of love that lasts beyond fleeting emotions and changes hearts.

3.	Reflect on how trusting and hoping in God helps you love others better.

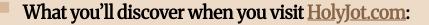
