For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."

Day 1: **B** Trusting God's Provision

Devotional: Release Worry and Trust God's Faithful Provision

As the breadwinner, it's easy to feel the weight of responsibility pressing down hard. The constant worries about providing for your family, balancing expenses, and making wise decisions can steal your peace. Jesus reminds us not to be consumed by these anxieties but to seek first His Kingdom and righteousness. *God knows your needs intimately and promises to provide for them.*

Your confidence grows not in your paycheck or your plans but in the faithfulness of God who sees and sustains you. When you cast your cares on Him, you release the burden of control and embrace the rest He offers. Devotional: Renew Your Strength by Relying on God
