Day 1: 💋 Finding Peace Amidst Change

Your Verse

Philippians 4:6-7 – "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

Supporting Scriptures

- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."
- Matthew 6:34 "Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself."







Day 1: **B** Finding Peace Amidst Change

Devotional: God's Peace Guards Your Heart

When a job loss or unexpected career change stirs anxiety, God invites us to bring our worries directly to Him. Philippians 4:6–7 tells us not to be anxious but to pray about every concern, presenting them with thanksgiving. This act of surrender opens the door for us to experience **God's deep peace** — a peace that isn't dependent on our external situation.

It's natural to feel uncertain about the future, but God promises to guard our hearts and minds when we look to Him. This peace helps us face daily challenges without being overwhelmed. The encouragement from Isaiah 41:10 reminds us that God is always present, strengthening and upholding us.

Rather than being consumed by fear about what lies ahead, Matthew 6:34 teaches us to trust God's provision for tomorrow, one day at a time. Today, choose to cast your cares on God and receive the calm assurance that only He can provide.

Day 2: K God's Purpose in Every Season

Devotional: Trusting God's Good Plans

Losing a job or facing drastic career changes can make us feel like our future is uncertain or even hopeless. Yet, God's Word in Jeremiah 29:11 assures us that He already knows the plans He has for our lives—plans filled with hope and purpose.

Even when our circumstances look bleak, God is working behind the scenes.

Romans 8:28 reassures us that He uses every event, good or bad, for our ultimate good when we love Him and keep Him at the center. This doesn't mean all hardships are easy or pleasant, but that God's sovereignty and love guide our path.

Trusting God with all our heart can be difficult when our understanding is limited, but Proverbs 3:5–6 encourages us to submit our ways to Him. When we do, He promises to direct our steps and lead us in the right direction—even through job transitions.

Remember, your current season is part of God's larger story of redemption and growth for you. Hold onto hope knowing He is working for your good.

Your Verse

Isaiah 40:31 - "But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength." They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."
- 2 Corinthians 12:9 "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."







Day 3: ① Standing Firm in God's Strength

Devotional: Renewing Strength Through Hope

Job loss can leave us feeling drained and hopeless, but Isaiah 40:31 promises that those who place their hope in the LORD will find renewed strength to rise above their challenges. This strength isn't from ourselves but from God, who empowers us to keep moving forward.

God is our refuge and source of strength, especially in times of trouble (Psalm 46:1). When we feel weak or discouraged, we can rely on His faithful presence. Paul's experience in 2 Corinthians 12 reminds us that God's grace is enough for us. His power becomes most apparent when we acknowledge our limitations.

Rather than shrinking back in despair, trust God to fortify your spirit. Through hope in Him, you can face each day with renewed energy and courage. Allow His strength to lift you, empower your job search, or shape your next career steps.

Matthew 6:31-33 - "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 37:25 "I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous forsaken or their children begging bread."
- Philippians 4:19 "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus."







Devotional: God Provides When We Seek Him

One of the greatest fears during unemployment or job uncertainty is the worry about provision. However, Matthew 6:31–33 encourages us to prioritize seeking God's kingdom and righteousness first, trusting that He knows our needs and will provide for them.

God's faithfulness in provision is proven throughout Scripture. David declares in Psalm 37:25 that the Lord never forsakes the righteous. Similarly, Paul assures us in Philippians 4:19 that God will meet all our needs from His glorious riches when we trust Him.

Instead of being consumed by anxiety over resources, refocus your heart on God's kingdom work and your relationship with Him. His provision comes in many forms—sometimes through unexpected opportunities, community help, or divine favor. Remember, your worth and security are anchored in God's love, not your paycheck.

2.	How can you seek God's kingdom 'first' in your current season?
3.	What evidence of God's provision have you witnessed in the past?

Prayer for Today

God of Provision, thank You for knowing my every need before I ask. Help me to seek Your kingdom and righteousness above all else, trusting that You will supply everything I require. Calm my worry about financial and career uncertainties, and teach me to depend fully on Your faithful provision. Thank You for Your abundant love. *In Jesus' name, Amen.*

Supporting Scriptures

- James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault."
- Proverbs 16:9 "In their hearts humans plan their course, but the LORD establishes their steps."







Devotional: God's Loving Guidance for Your Path

Facing uncertainty about the next steps in your career can be overwhelming. Psalm 32:8 promises God's personal guidance—He will instruct, teach, and counsel us with loving care about the way we should go. This is a precious promise when the path ahead feels unclear.

God invites us to ask for wisdom boldly. James 1:5 reminds us that He generously gives wisdom to everyone who asks without doubting. When we seek Him earnestly, He illuminates our path.

While we may plan and dream, Proverbs 16:9 reminds us that ultimately God directs our steps. Trusting His guidance means being willing to adjust our course as He leads. Stay attentive to His voice through prayer, Scripture, and wise counsel.

Embrace the joy of walking step-by-step with the Lord as your guide.

Your Verse

James 1:2-4 - "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance."

Supporting Scriptures

- Romans 5:3-4 "Suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope."
- 1 Peter 1:6-7 "Though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief... these trials have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith —of greater worth than gold—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed."







Day 6: F Growing Through Trials

Devotional: Faith Strengthened by Career Trials

Job loss and career uncertainty are hard trials, but James 1:2-4 challenges us to find joy in them because they produce spiritual perseverance. These testing times refine our faith, helping us grow stronger and more resilient.

Paul explains in Romans 5:3-4 that suffering builds character and hope.

When we face disappointment, God is shaping our hearts and preparing us for greater things. Though painful, these experiences develop maturity that can only come through trust in Him.

Peter reminds us that trials prove the genuineness of our faith, which will be rewarded. This eternal perspective gives us strength to endure. Don't waste the pain; let God use it to cultivate perseverance and hope in your life.

Today, embrace this season as a growth opportunity, trusting God to bring beauty from ashes.

Day 7: Embracing God's Timing

Your Verse

Ecclesiastes 3:1 - "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens."

Supporting Scriptures

- Habakkuk 2:3 "For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay."
- Psalm 27:14 "Wait for the LORD; be strong and take heart and wait for the LORD."







Devotional: Patience in God's Perfect Timing

When experiencing job loss or unexpected career changes, waiting can be the hardest part. Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us there is a divine timing for everything. God orchestrates seasons in our lives for ultimate good.

Habakkuk 2:3 calls us to patiently wait for God's promises, even if they seem delayed. His timing is always perfect, and He never forgets His word.

Psalm 27:14 encourages us to be strong and courageous while waiting. Trusting God's timing requires faith that He is working all things for your benefit, even when you can't see it yet. As you wait, lean into His strength and keep your heart open.

Today, rest in the assurance that God's plans unfold at just the right time. Be patient, remain hopeful, and prepare your heart for new opportunities.
