Devotional: God's Strength in Our Weakness

When faced with a serious health diagnosis like cystic fibrosis, the natural response can be fear and anxiety. Yet, **Psalm 46:1 reminds us that God is our refuge and strength**, providing a sanctuary when life feels overwhelming. This verse reassures us that God is not distant during our trials — He is an ever-present help.

In Isaiah 41:10, God commands us not to fear because He is with us, even when our bodies or circumstances feel fragile. Paul's admission of weakness in 2 Corinthians 12:9 shows us that God's grace shines brightest when we acknowledge our dependence on Him. Our limitations open the door for divine strength.

Trusting God in your health journey means leaning into His protection and power more than your own understanding or strength. It is by resting in His presence that peace begins to replace fear. Use today to invite God to be your refuge and to surrender your worries into His capable hands.

Day 2: **B** The Lord Heals and Restores

Devotional: God's Promise to Heal and Restore

God identifies Himself as the healer in **Exodus 15:26**, a promise that resonates deeply when living with cystic fibrosis. This declaration is not only about physical healing but also emotional and spiritual restoration.

Jeremiah 30:17 tells us God actively restores health and heals wounds, offering hope beyond immediate circumstances. Healing can sometimes be a process, and God's restoration might take many forms — peace, strength, or physical relief.

James 5:15 confirms the power of prayer in healing, emphasizing faith's role in inviting God's healing touch. While cures aren't always instantaneous or complete, trusting God's treatment plan can bring profound comfort and perseverance.

Today, focus on God's healing nature, inviting His restoration in all areas of your life. Believe His promise that He is at work even in your struggle, making a way for hope and renewal.

Day 3: W Trust in God's Peace Amidst Uncertainty

Devotional: God's Peace Overcoming Anxiety

Chronic illness often breeds anxiety and fear about what lies ahead. Yet, in **Philippians 4:6-7**, Paul encourages us not to be anxious. Instead, we can bring every concern to God in prayer, and He promises His peace—a peace beyond human comprehension—to guard our hearts and minds.

Jesus in John 14:27 promises a peace unlike any the world offers, offering calm in the storm. When anxiety threatens to overwhelm, God's presence can bring deep consolation and joy, as expressed in Psalm 94:19.

Choosing to trust God and cast our worries on Him opens the door to experiencing supernatural peace. Even when circumstances remain challenging, His peace can steady the soul and encourage perseverance.

Today, invite God's peace into the anxious spaces of your heart. Share your fears with Him and welcome His comforting presence.

Your Verse

Isaiah 40:29–31 – He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

Supporting Scriptures

- Nehemiah 8:10 The joy of the Lord is your strength.
- Psalm 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart.







Devotional: Renewed Strength in God's Power

Chronic illness can drain physical and emotional energy, leaving us weary. Yet Isaiah 40:29–31 encourages those who feel exhausted by promising God will renew their strength. Those who wait on the Lord will find their power increased like the soaring eagle.

Nehemiah 8:10 reminds us that joy in the Lord fuels our strength, even when circumstances feel heavy. Strength is not only physical but also spiritual and emotional.

Psalm 73:26 highlights a profound truth: though our bodies may weaken, God remains the unshakable strength of our hearts. This divine strength empowers us to face daily challenges with courage and hope.

Today, choose to draw from God's limitless strength. Trust that He will sustain and uplift you through each new day.

Devotional: Finding Joy and Peace Through Hope

Living with a chronic illness can sometimes cloud our future with doubt. Romans 15:13 encourages us to be filled with joy and peace as we place our hope in God, the ultimate source of hope.

Lamentations 3:22–23 reminds us that God's compassions are new every morning, ensuring we are never consumed by despair. His steadfast love continually renews our hope and strength.

Psalm 62:5 calls us to find rest and hope solely in God, centering our lives and emotions on His unchanging character rather than on shifting circumstances.

Hope becomes an anchor during health storms, holding us steady. Today, choose to anchor your hope in God's promises. Let joy and peace blossom within as you trust Him, no matter the trials.

Devotional: Faith's Assurance Beyond Sight

Faith is the lifeline when medical news feels discouraging or progress slow. Hebrews 11:1 defines faith as confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. This kind of faith sustains us through uncertainty.

Paul's testimony in 2 Timothy 4:7 highlights perseverance and commitment to faith despite challenges. Like Paul, we are called to fight the good fight, holding tightly to hope.

Psalm 27:13 expresses unwavering confidence in God's goodness even before we see it fully manifested. Faith is a daily choice to trust God beyond visible evidence.

Through the ups and downs of cystic fibrosis, choosing faith can shine as a testimony to God's sustaining power. Reflect on your own faith journey today and ask God to strengthen your unwavering trust in Him.

Devotional: Finding Rest in God's Tender Care
