Introduction

Day 1: 7 When God Is Silent

Devotional: Finding Hope When God Seems Silent

Have you ever cried out to God and felt like He wasn't listening? David's words in Psalm 13 reveal the deep emotion of feeling forgotten or abandoned by God, which is something many teens can relate to. It's okay to express your honest feelings before God, including doubt and sorrow. He desires your authentic heart, not perfection.

God's silence isn't always a sign that He doesn't care. Sometimes, in the silence, God is working in ways we cannot see or understand. Waiting is difficult, but it builds endurance and faith when we choose to keep hoping and seeking Him.

Remember, God's goodness surrounds those who wait on Him. Trust that your prayers matter, even if the timing feels delayed. Take comfort knowing your feelings are valid and God invites you to bring your honest questions to Him.

Day 2: Trusting God's Timing

Devotional: Embracing God's Perfect Timing

Learning to trust God's perfect timing is challenging but essential for our faith journey. Sometimes we want immediate answers, but God's timing always aligns with His greater purpose for our lives. Ecclesiastes reminds us there is a proper time for every event under heaven — including when prayers are answered.

The apostle Paul experienced unanswered prayers and asked God to remove a difficulty from his life, but God responded that His grace was enough. This shows us that even when things don't change as we wish, God's power can sustain and strengthen us.

When prayers seem unanswered or delayed, consider that God may be preparing you or working behind the scenes for something better. Trust grows when we embrace God's perfect timing instead of our own.

Day 3: Pinding Peace in God's Plan

Your Verse

Jeremiah 29:11 NIV – "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

Supporting Scriptures

- Philippians 4:6-7 "Do not be anxious about anything... And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."
- Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."







Day 3: Pinding Peace in God's Plan

Devotional: Resting in God's Peace and Promise

When prayers feel unanswered, finding peace can be hard, but God promises a hopeful future for each of us. Jeremiah 29:11 gives assurance that God's plans are for our prosperity and peace, even if the path is unclear.

In moments of disappointment, bring your anxiety and burden to Jesus. He offers rest and peace beyond our understanding. Trusting God means releasing control and believing He is working for your best, even if you don't see it yet.

Make seeking God's peace a daily practice through prayer, Bible reading, and rest in His promises. This peace will guard your heart and give you courage to continue trusting God's plan.
