# Devotional: Begin Your Career by Trusting God Fully

# Devotional: Use Your God-Given Talents for His Glory

Your career is not just a job; it is a calling to serve others with the unique gifts God has given you. 1 Peter 4:10 reminds us that these gifts are a form of God's grace entrusted to us. When you understand your talents as part of God's provision, it changes how you view your work.

God has equipped each person differently—as Romans 12:6 highlights—and these differences are meant to complement each other in the body of Christ and the workplace. You are not here by accident; your skills, passions, and experiences prepare you to contribute meaningfully.

### Devotional: Experience God's Peace Amid Career Worries

# Devotional: Patience to Trust God's Career Timing

The timing of career opportunities often feels frustrating when answers don't come quickly. Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us that God has an appointed time and season for everything. Trusting God's timing requires patience and faith that His schedule is perfect.

Psalm 27:14 encourages us to wait with strength and courage—not passively, but actively trusting God's plan while preparing ourselves faithfully. Waiting is hard, yet God uses this period for growth, refinement, and alignment.
