Expect to engage with passages from Daniel, Joel, Acts, 1 Corinthians, and Revelation among others. You will gain a biblical framework to test prophetic







dreams and visions, recognize the fruit they produce, and understand their purpose in warning, encouraging, or correcting the Church.

Whether you have experienced dreams or visions yourself, or simply desire to be wise and discerning in this area, this devotional journey will deepen your understanding and trust in God's ways. Let us open our hearts and minds to the Holy Spirit's leading as we seek to rightly interpret prophetic revelations in these times.

### Devotional: God's Promise to Reveal Through Dreams and Visions

Today, we begin by discovering how God uses dreams and visions to communicate with His people. The prophet Joel prophesied that in the last days, God would pour out His Spirit on all people, leading to sons and daughters prophesying, old men dreaming dreams, and young men seeing visions. This promise highlights the enduring importance of supernatural revelation throughout history and especially in the times leading up to Christ's return.

Why does God choose dreams and visions? These forms of communication often transcend human limitations, allowing God to impress spiritual truths directly in ways the human mind may not conceive on its own. They can serve as warnings, encouragement, or insights into future events.

In Numbers, God declares that when He chooses a prophet, He reveals Himself in visions and speaks through dreams. The early church, as recorded in Acts, recognized this outpouring of the Spirit manifested in dreams and visions as evidence of God's activity in the last days.

As we move forward in this study, remember that God's desire is to draw us closer and prepare His people wisely. He invites us into a relationship where we listen attentively to how He might be speaking through dreams and visions.

#### Devotional: Learning From Joseph's Prophetic Dreams

Joseph's life is a profound example of God using dreams to reveal His plans. In Genesis 37, Joseph's prophetic dreams forecasted his future elevation and the role he would play in preserving his family during famine. Though misunderstood and resented by his brothers, Joseph remained faithful to God's revelation.

In Daniel's story, dreams and visions serve as God's method to reveal mysteries about kingdoms and the future, emphasizing that such revelations are divine secrets entrusted to His servants.

Even in the New Testament, Joseph, the earthly father of Jesus, receives divine guidance through dreams—being warned to flee to Egypt and later to return—highlighting the protective and directive role of dreams.

What stands out is that prophetic dreams often come with responsibility and sometimes opposition, but they are vital tools in God's hand to accomplish His purposes.

### Devotional: Testing and Valuing Prophecy in the Last Days

Prophecy is an essential gift within the Church, especially in the context of the End Times. The Apostle Paul urges believers not to disdain prophecies but to test them carefully and cling to what is good. This instruction highlights both the value and the caution needed regarding prophetic words.

The book of Revelation emphasizes that prophecy carries the testimony of Jesus Himself. Prophetic messages should align with Christ's character and purposes, building up the church and offering hope and correction.

Prophecy is meant to strengthen, encourage, and comfort the Body of Christ, especially during challenging times. However, because we live in times of deception, biblical evaluation of prophetic messages is crucial.

We see that prophecy is God's way of speaking to His people, but it demands wisdom and discernment to ensure its authenticity and impact.

### Devotional: How to Discern Dreams That Are from God

**Testing prophetic dreams is not optional but essential.** Scripture gives clear instructions to test all spirits and prophetic claims. Not every dream is from God — some may originate from fears, desires, or even deceptive spirits.

Deuteronomy reminds us to check the fulfillment of the prophecy: if it fails to come to pass, it is not from the Lord. Jesus teaches to recognize false prophets by their fruits — the evidence of their lives and the impact of their messages.

So how can we test dreams and visions? First, align them with the truth of God's Word. Second, evaluate the character and life of the person delivering or experiencing the prophecy. Third, observe the spiritual fruits such as faith, hope, and love growing as a result.

By applying biblical tests diligently, we protect ourselves and our communities from deception and stay anchored in God's revealed truth.

- Daniel 7:9 "The Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was as white as snow."







### Devotional: Understanding the Language of Visions

Biblical visions often use vivid symbols and imagery to convey deep spiritual truths. Ezekiel's majestic vision of God's throne, the four living creatures, and the spirit wheels is full of symbolism that points to divine power and holiness.

Similarly, Revelation's apocalyptic visions communicate realities about the heavenly realm, Christ's majesty, and end-time events using symbolic colors, numbers, and creatures. Daniel's visions also blend symbolic imagery to reveal God's sovereign control over earthly kingdoms.

It's important to approach these symbols prayerfully and humbly, seeking the Spirit's guidance and cross-referencing Scripture for clarity. Avoid overly literal interpretations and remember that symbols often convey mysteries beyond human words.

Mastering the language of visions strengthens our ability to hear God's messages clearly and respond appropriately.

# Devotional: Recognizing Divine Inspiration in Prophecy

True prophetic words do not originate from human imagination or desire but from the Holy Spirit. Peter reminds us that prophecy in Scripture was given by people moved by the Spirit, emphasizing divine rather than personal agenda.

Jeremiah warns against false prophets who speak peace without repentance or truth. We are called to discern whether prophetic voices align with God's nature, Word, and righteousness.

John encourages believers to distinguish spirits by how they testify about Christ — the core of all true prophecy. Prophetic authority is validated by its fidelity to Jesus and Scripture.

In testing prophetic dreams and visions, ask if they exalt Christ and align with biblical truth. This is the touchstone of prophetic authenticity.

# Devotional: Guarding Your Heart and Mind from Deception

Jesus warns believers that in the End Times, false prophets will arise performing signs to deceive many, even the elect. This sobering warning compels us to guard against deception carefully.

Paul confronts those masquerading as apostles but spreading falsehood, showing how deception often involves distortion of truth paired with impressive works.

Jeremiah condemns self-appointed prophets who deliver lies claiming God's authority but lacking His sanction.

To protect ourselves, we must be deeply rooted in Scripture, cultivate the Holy Spirit's discernment, and maintain humility and prayerfulness. Verification, counsel from mature believers, and testing messages against biblical truths are practical safeguards.

Remember, vigilance is vital so that we walk confidently in God's truth, not error.

Paul reminds Timothy that all Scripture is inspired by God and thoroughly equips us for every good work, including spiritual discernment.

Psalm 119 beautifully celebrates God's Word as our guiding light, piercing darkness and confusion.

When receiving a prophetic dream or vision, the first and non-negotiable test is whether it corresponds with Scripture. Anything contrary to God's revealed word is not from Him.

Let us commit to saturate ourselves in Scripture so that no vision or dream can mislead us or pull us away from God's truth.

# Devotional: Evaluating the Impact of Prophetic Dreams

The fruit produced by prophetic dreams and visions is a crucial sign of their authenticity. Paul describes the fruit of the Spirit as love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control — qualities that should overflow in any true revelation from God.

Jesus affirms that good fruit is the measure to recognize the true origin of prophecies and prophets. Without love at the core, even bold claims and miracles are empty.

Ask: Does the prophetic dream promote God's character and encourage holiness, hope, and unity? If it causes division, fear, or strife—be cautious.

Assessing fruit helps protect against deception and ensures our responses please God.

Ezekiel reveals the prophet's responsibility to warn the wicked. Ignoring such warnings brings judgment, showing how prophetic messages carry serious accountability.

Jesus, speaking to His churches in Revelation, confirms that His love expresses itself through correction and discipline — an essential prophetic function for growth and holiness.

Thus, prophetic dreams and visions often come as loving interventions, calling us back to God's path while offering hope and reassurance.

Recognizing this balance helps us receive prophecy in the Spirit of love and humility.

# Devotional: Seeking Wisdom Through Spiritual Community

God designed the Church as a community where prophetic words are tested collectively. Proverbs emphasizes the importance of wise counsel to avoid mistakes and find safety.

The early Church demonstrated this principle by gathering leaders to confirm and clarify prophetic insights, as seen in Acts.

Paul instructs believers to weigh prophetic words carefully in a communal setting, ensuring accountability and collective discernment.

When you experience a prophetic dream or vision, sharing it with mature believers who are committed to Scripture and the Spirit's guidance can help confirm its authenticity.

Community protects us from isolation and spiritual error in interpreting God's messages.
