Introduction

Welcome to your 3-day journey toward developing an unshakable faith! *Teen years* are full of growth, new experiences, and sometimes, challenges that test what you believe. Peer pressure, doubts, and life's ups and downs can often shake our confidence. This study is designed to help you learn how to build your life firmly on Christ, so when storms come, your faith remains solid and unshaken.

Imagine a house built on rock versus sand (Matthew 7:24–27). A house on sand will collapse when the storm hits, but a house on rock stands strong. That rock is like faith in Jesus — when it's rock–solid, no wave of pressure or challenge can knock you down. Over these three days, we'll explore how faith can become that foundation.

You'll discover how trusting God, embracing His word, and relying on His strength can empower you to say no to peer pressure and yes to a life filled with purpose and hope. Whether you feel confident today or are still growing, this study will encourage and equip you to stand firm.

Remember, faith isn't about never facing difficulties — it's about who you lean on when life gets tough. Get ready to dig deep, ask honest questions, and grow stronger in your walk with God!

Your Verse

Proverbs 3:5-6 - "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 56:3 "When I am afraid, I put my trust in you."
- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God."







Day 1: Trusting God Above All

Devotional: Building Faith Through Total Trust in God

Trust is the foundation of unshakable faith. When peer pressure tries to pull you away or challenges make you doubt, remembering to trust God completely is key. Proverbs 3:5–6 reminds us to trust the Lord with all our heart and not rely solely on what we think or feel. Sometimes, our own understanding can be limited or clouded by fear and confusion.

Trusting God means believing that He knows the way better than we do, even when we don't understand the situation. It doesn't mean challenges won't happen, but rather that God will guide us through them. Psalm 56:3 encourages us to turn to God when afraid, showing that faith grows stronger as we seek Him in tough times.

Take a moment today to remember God's promise in Isaiah 41:10: you don't have to be afraid because God is with you. *Trusting Him fully will build a faith that isn't shaken by the opinions or pressures of others.*

Day 2: T Standing Firm in Jesus

Your Verse

Ephesians 6:13 – "Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand."

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 Corinthians 16:13 "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong."
- James 1:2-4 "Consider it pure joy... whenever you face trials of many kinds... because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance."







Day 2: T Standing Firm in Jesus

Devotional: Courageously Wearing God's Armor Daily

Faith isn't passive; it requires strength and courage. Ephesians 6:13 tells us to 'put on the full armor of God' to stand strong when difficulties come. This armor includes truth, righteousness, and faith itself. Imagine each piece as protection against the pressures that seek to weaken your soul.

When peer pressure tempts you to conform or when challenges make you question your beliefs, it's the armor of God that equips you to stand firm. 1 Corinthians 16:13 encourages us to be brave and strong, not shrinking back but holding tight to what we know is true.

Moreover, James reminds us that trials aren't meaningless — they produce perseverance, building depth to our faith. Every difficulty is an opportunity to grow stronger and more determined in your walk with Christ. This perspective turns hardships into stepping stones rather than stumbling blocks.

3.	List Scriptural truths that encourage you to stand strong.



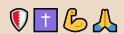




Day 2: The Standing Firm in Jesus

- Psalm 1:3 "That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season."







Day 3: Forowing Unshakable Faith

Devotional: Rooted and Growing Strong in Christ

Faith is a journey of growth and depth. Colossians 2:6–7 encourages us to walk in Jesus, being rooted and built up in Him, much like a tree planted by water. This kind of faith doesn't stay small or shallow; it grows deep, strong, and fruitful, even in the face of storms.

To develop unshakable faith, you need nourishment—from God's Word, prayer, community, and thankfulness. Hebrews 10:23 reminds us to hold on to hope because God's promises are sure. When you remain connected to Him daily, your roots get stronger.

Psalm 1:3 beautifully illustrates this life: a person rooted in God is steady and fruitful, no matter what challenges arise. As you grow, your faith will increasingly influence your thoughts, decisions, and relationships.

Today, reflect on where your faith is rooted and how you can cultivate a deeper connection with Christ every day.
