#### Your Verse

Psalm 18:2 - "The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 84:11 "The Lord bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless."
- Isaiah 41:10 "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."







#### Devotional: God Is Your Stronghold and Shield

For a veteran facing injustice, the metaphor of God as a shield is powerful and personal. You have stood behind physical shields, protecting others and yourself in combat—now, God promises to be your defender in spiritual and earthly battles.

Psalm 18:2 reminds us that God is not only a refuge but a stronghold when life feels like an ongoing legal or systemic battle. When feelings of abandonment or unfair treatment arise, cling to the assurance that God has not abandoned you. His strength is perfect when our strength is gone.

Consider what it means for God to be your horn of salvation — a symbol of power and victory. This is the promise that victory over injustice is possible because He fights for you. Cry out to Him to be your shield today and allow His divine protection to bring peace in the midst of chaos.

#### Your Verse

Isaiah 1:17 – "Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 103:6 "The Lord works righteousness and justice for all the oppressed."
- Proverbs 21:15 "When justice is done, it brings joy to the righteous but terror to evildoers."







Day 2: God's Justice Overcomes Injustice

#### Devotional: Trusting God's Perfect Justice

Injustices can feel overwhelming, but God's justice is the foundation for hope. Isaiah 1:17 is a call to action, both divine and personal: to seek justice and stand for those mistreated or vulnerable. As a veteran, you may feel called not just to endure but to advocate.

- James 4:7 "Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."







#### Devotional: Arm Yourself Spiritually for Battle

Veterans are familiar with physical armor; now, scripture invites you to don the full armor of God. Spiritual warfare rages not only in battlefields but behind the scenes—within injustice, slander, and deceit.

Ephesians teaches us to equip ourselves with truth, righteousness, faith, and the word of God. These divine armaments protect and empower you to stand firm when falsely accused or mistreated.

#### Devotional: Trusting God for Final Victory

After days of reflection and prayer, we close knowing that ultimate victory belongs to God. Deuteronomy 20:4 reminds us that the Lord fights for you, not just at your side, but on your behalf.
