Devotional: Protecting Your Heart Through Gratitude

Our hearts are the battlegrounds where envy often takes root. Proverbs 4:23 reminds us that everything we do flows from our hearts, so guarding it is essential. Envy enters when we compare ourselves to others, losing sight of the unique path God has set for us.

Galatians 5:26 warns against provoking and envying others, which disrupts unity and joy. Instead, *Romans 12:15* calls us to rejoice sincerely with others. Shifting from envy to celebration is a powerful act of spiritual warfare.
