Your Verse

Psalm 139:1-4 - "You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you, Lord, know it completely."

Devotional: Understanding God's Intimate Knowledge of You

Your Verse

1 Samuel 1:10-11 - "In her deep anguish Hannah prayed to the Lord, weeping bitterly. And she made a vow, saying, 'Lord Almighty, if you will only look on your servant's misery and remember me..."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 34:17 "The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles."
- Matthew 7:7 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you."







Devotional: Finding Hope in God's Listening Ear

Hannah's story is one of deep emotional pain and fervent prayer. She felt desperate and possibly overlooked in her desire for a child, yet she chose to pour out her heart honestly before God.

This passage reminds us that God hears the silent cries of women whose longings feel invisible to others. When family and friends fail to notice your heartache or exhaustion, you are encouraged to bring your burdens to the Lord.

Like Hannah, you can trust that God listens attentively to your prayers—even those whispered in quiet and solitude. Your heartfelt petitions are precious to Him, and He is faithful to act in His timing and according to His perfect will.

Devotional: Choosing Rest and Connection with God

Mary chose to sit quietly and attentively with Jesus, prioritizing spiritual connection over busyness. This challenges us to find balance in our lives, especially when our faithfulness feels like nonstop work.
