#### Devotional: The Power of Loving in Truth

**3 John opens** with John's warm greeting to Gaius, commending him for his faithful walk 'in the truth.' This phrase highlights the inseparable connection between truth and love in the Christian life. John's affection for Gaius is rooted in shared commitment to God's word and living it out authentically.

Walking in truth means embracing the gospel wholeheartedly, rejecting falsehood, and embodying God's commands. But it is not a cold or distant truth; it is alive and expressed through genuine love. The early church faced many challenges, including doctrinal disputes and social pressures, yet believers like Gaius stood firm, supporting those who spread the Good News.

#### Your Verse

3 John 1:9-12 "I wrote to the church, but Diotrephes..."

#### **Supporting Scriptures**

- 2 Timothy 2:24–26 "The Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone."
- Titus 3:10 "Warn a divisive person once, and then warn them a second time. After that, have nothing to do with them."







Day 3: <u>A</u> Guarding Truth and Rejecting Discord

#### Devotional: Standing Firm Against Discord

John warns about Diotrephes, who refused to welcome the brethren and spread malicious words against John, acting selfishly and disrupting fellowship. This reminds believers that not all opposition is external; sometimes conflict comes from within the church itself.

Guarding the truth involves discernment and courage to confront or avoid those who hinder unity and oppose godly leadership. It requires balancing grace with firmness to protect the church's witness.

**Disunity damages the body** and can steal the joy of fellowship. John's example teaches us to prioritize truth and love but also to be wise, standing against those who cause division.

Reflect on how you respond to conflict in your faith community and whether you promote peace and truth or inadvertently contribute to discord.
