Psalm 111:1 - "Praise the Lord. I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart, in the company of the upright, in the congregation."

#### Devotional: Beginning with Reverence and Awe

- Isaiah 33:6 "He will be the sure foundation for your times, a rich store of salvation and wisdom and knowledge; the fear of the Lord is the key to this treasure."







#### Devotional: Faithful God, Trustworthy Covenant

**Today's focus is the connection between fearing the Lord and trusting in His faithfulness.** Psalm 111 praises God's works as faithful and just, highlighting His enduring covenant and trustworthy commands. Walking in the fear of the Lord means embracing not only awe but also confident dependence on His promises.

When we fear God, we commit to live according to His precepts because we trust His justice and love. This trust deepens our faith and provides a firm foundation in times of uncertainty. God's covenant is eternal; our fear of Him leads us into a relationship marked by reliability and holiness.

#### Your Verse

- Psalm 112:4 "Even in darkness light dawns for the upright, for those who are gracious and compassionate and righteous."







#### Devotional: Wisdom and Blessings in Reverence

On our final day, we celebrate the blessings that flow from walking in the fear of the Lord. Psalm 111 culminates in a powerful truth: the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, guiding us to good understanding and eternal praise. Choosing to reverence God shapes our character and aligns us with His eternal purposes.
