Day 1: W Guarding the Truth

Your Verse

2 John 1:1-6 - "The elder, To the lady chosen by God and to her children, whom I love in the truth—and not only I, but also all who know the truth—because of the truth, which lives in us and will be with us forever."

Supporting Scriptures

- John 17:17 "Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth."
- Ephesians 4:14 "Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching."







Day 1: W Guarding the Truth

Devotional: Loving Others by Guarding the Truth

John begins his letter by emphasizing love grounded in truth. It reminds us that genuine Christian love is inseparable from adherence to God's Word. The "lady chosen by God and her children" likely symbolizes a local church and its members, highlighting the communal aspect of faith. Loving in truth means embracing God's revealed Word and living it out sincerely together.

This passage calls us to *guard the truth* diligently. False teaching threatens the community from within and without. Just as John warns, believers must be vigilant not to accept every new teaching but evaluate it through God's Word. The "truth that lives in us" is not a mere idea; it is a vibrant reality transforming our hearts and actions.

Being grounded in truth provides stability. Without it, the church and individual believers become vulnerable—"tossed... by every wind of teaching." Our world continues to be filled with competing ideas and philosophies. The safeguard is to abide in the truth.

As you reflect today, consider the sources that shape your beliefs. Are they in harmony with Scripture? How can you protect yourself and your faith community from deception? This is not just guarding information but loving one another enough to preserve the gospel's purity.

Rejecting Deception

Your Verse

2 John 1:7-11 - "Many deceivers, who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh, have gone out into the world... anyone who does not remain in him is not keeping God's commands."

Supporting Scriptures

- 1 John 4:2-3 "Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God..."
- Matthew 7:15 "Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves."







Day 2:

Rejecting Deception

Devotional: Standing Firm Against False Teaching

This passage warns of the dangers posed by deceivers denying the incarnation of Christ. The denial that Jesus came in the flesh is a critical error because it undermines the foundation of the gospel—the true humanity and divinity of Jesus. Such false teaching threatens believers' faith and can lead them away from salvation.

John exhorts believers to reject anyone who promotes these heresies and to refrain from offering them hospitality or support. This does not mean a harsh spirit but rather protecting the community from harmful influences that might cause others to stumble in faith.

The call to "remain in him" signals abiding in Christ's teaching and commandments, a vital way to live out authentic faith. When we choose truth, we naturally reject what contradicts it. This day challenges us to be intentional about the company we keep and the teachings we endorse.

How vigilant are you in protecting your heart and your community from spiritual deception? The apostle's instruction stresses that love for God and others includes defending the gospel's integrity, sometimes requiring difficult boundaries.

Supporting Scriptures

- John 15:10 "If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love..."
- Colossians 3:14 "And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity."







Day 3: Walking in Love and Obedience

Devotional: Joy in Obedient, Loving Fellowship

John's closing thoughts highlight the joy found in personal fellowship that blends love and obedience. Although this letter is short, it points to the deep relationship between walking faithfully in obedience to God's commands and experiencing the fullness of Christian joy.

The apostle desires face-to-face fellowship, reminding us that spiritual truth grows in the context of community. Joy in the Christian life is anchored as much in relationships of authentic love and accountability as it is in personal devotion.

Walking in love and obedience is an ongoing pursuit. Obedience without love can become legalism; love without obedience may lack godly boundaries. The beauty of the Christian walk is that God calls us to both, promising joy and unity when we heed His commands motivated by love.

As you conclude this study, consider your journey of faith: Are you cultivating joy through obedient love? How can you foster deeper fellowship that reflects the heart of Christ?
