Kid-Friendly Devotional

Have you ever talked to someone and felt like they weren't really listening? Maybe they were looking at their phone or thinking about something else. Good news—**God is never distracted!**

P Big Idea

You don't have to face anything alone—**God gives you courage!**

Kid-Friendly Devotional

Everyone feels scared sometimes. Maybe it's a test, a dark room, or trying something new. But here's the great news: **God goes with you wherever you go**. You never walk into anything alone!

God doesn't just say, "Be brave"—He says, "**I'm right here with you.**" That's the kind of bravery that isn't about being tough on the outside—it's about **knowing Who's standing beside you** on the inside.

You might still feel nervous. That's okay. But with God, you can take a deep breath and step forward—**together**.

P Big Idea

Kid-Friendly Devotional
