## Devotional: Trusting God's Ever-Present Help

Psalm 46:1 reminds us that God is not a distant observer but an ever-present help in times of trouble. When He seems to walk away, it is often our perspective that shifts, not His presence.

# Devotional: Hope and Strength in God's Timing

# Devotional: Anchoring Your Identity in God's Design

Women often face pressure to define themselves by roles, appearance, or achievements. Yet Psalm 139 reminds us that our truest identity is found in God's creative love. He designed each of us with intentionality and wonder.

Consider Mary, chosen by God amidst ordinary circumstances, yet honored and valued because of who He made her to be. Her story is a testament to the power of embracing God's purpose rather than the world's expectations.

When God seems distant, remembering that He made you and loves you perfectly can anchor your identity and worth. This truth brings stability when external validation fades.

### **Supporting Scriptures**

- Psalm 34:18 "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."
- Isaiah 40:29 "He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak."







### Devotional: God's Power Perfected in Your Weakness

Every woman faces moments of brokenness or weakness, but God's grace offers strength in these times. Paul's words in 2 Corinthians remind us that God's power shines brightest where we are weakest.

Think of women like Naomi, who faced loss and bitterness, yet found restoration through God's grace. Their stories encourage us to surrender our weakness and lean into God's strength rather than our own.

When God seems to walk away, His grace is actually working deeply in our lives, perfecting His power even in struggle and pain. Embracing grace lets us find stability in His strength, not in ourselves.
