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Introduction

During this study, you will explore key Psalms where David asks for discernment, discern the qualities of godly wisdom, and reflect on how to invite the Holy Spirit to guide your steps daily. You'll find that biblical wisdom is deeply relational: it grows as we connect more intimately with our Creator and surrender our own plans. Whether you are facing big life decisions or daily challenges, David's prayers offer a model for approaching God with transparency and trust.

Let this journey inspire you to pursue wisdom not just as knowledge, but as a gift from God that transforms your heart and leads you to live well in His eyes.

















Your Verse

Psalm 111:10 - "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding."

Supporting Scriptures

- Proverbs 9:10 "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding."
- Psalm 34:11 "Come, my children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD."







Devotional: Fear of the Lord: The Foundation of Wisdom

David opens his prayers with recognition that true wisdom begins with reverence for God. To 'fear the Lord' is not about being scared, but about having awe and respect for His holiness and power. This fear sets the foundation for all wise living. When we align ourselves with God's standards and seek to understand His ways, we cultivate true understanding.

This psalm reminds us that wisdom is not something we can conjure up on our own; it starts with a right attitude toward God Himself. David's prayer points us to a posture of humility that welcomes God's guidance. As we face daily decisions, anchoring our hearts in God's precepts provides clarity and peace.

Ask yourself if you are approaching God with reverence and a teachable heart. Let today's reflection encourage you to reorient your heart toward God's fear as the gateway to wisdom.










Day 2: 🙏 David's Cry for Direction









Your Verse

Psalm 25:4-5 - "Show me your ways, LORD, teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long."

Supporting Scriptures

- Psalm 143:8 "Let the morning bring me word of your unfailing love, for I have put my trust in you. Show me the way I should go, for to you I entrust my life."
- Isaiah 30:21 "Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it.'"







Devotional: Seeking God's Path in Times of Uncertainty

David's prayer reveals a heartfelt plea for God's guidance and direction. When we don't know the way forward, it is natural to feel anxious or confused. Yet David's example shows us we can come before God in honesty, asking Him to teach us His paths and guide our steps. The repeated request to 'show me your ways' indicates a deep desire to align with God's truth rather than following our own instincts.

Trusting God for guidance means surrendering control and placing our hope fully in Him. David reminds us that God is our Savior and constant hope, meaning we can confidently entrust our lives to Him for wisdom. As we seek God daily, He promises to direct us through His word, through the prompting of the Holy Spirit, and through circumstances.

Reflect on how you seek direction—do you turn first to God in prayer, or rely on your own understanding? Let this prayer shape your dependence on God's leading each day.

May Your word be a shield around me and a light on my path today.












Day 6: XX Trusting God's Timing
