Devotional: Hearing God's Voice Clearly and Wisely

God's voice is distinct to His children. Jesus describes believers as His sheep who recognize and follow His voice. This intimate relationship means He speaks in ways we can learn to discern. Wisdom opens our hearts to hear Him clearly through Scripture, prayer, and the quiet prompting of the Spirit.
