## Devotional: God's Promise to Provide Wisdom

**Choosing a spouse begins with seeking wisdom.** The Apostle James encourages us to ask God for wisdom, promising that He gives generously without reproach. This assurance brings comfort especially when decisions feel overwhelming. God is a loving Father who desires to guide us on the right path.

Often in relationships, emotions can cloud our judgment. We might be tempted to rely on personal feelings or popular culture standards, but God invites us to lean into His divine understanding. Proverbs reminds us to trust the Lord wholeheartedly—not on our own insight—and to submit to His will. When we do this, He promises to "make our paths straight," giving clarity in complex choices.

Before seeking a spouse, pray for wisdom. Ask God to reveal what is best, to protect you from harm, and to align your heart with His desires. Psalm 32 reminds us that God instructs and lovingly watches over us. Trust that same care in your pursuit of a life partner. This foundation of seeking God first will set the tone for a relationship rooted in faith and divine purpose.

## Devotional: Prioritizing Godly Character and Faith

**Choosing a spouse means choosing someone who shares your faith and values.** Paul's counsel in 2 Corinthians reminds believers not to be 'unequally yoked' with unbelievers. Spiritual unity forms a critical foundation for a lasting, harmonious relationship because mismatched beliefs often lead to conflict and distance.

Proverbs 31 highlights the importance of a partner who fears the Lord. Unlike temporary charm or physical attractiveness, godly character and reverence for God endure and deeply impact marriage. When your spouse desires to walk with the Lord, it cultivates an environment where love, respect, and mutual growth flourish.

For men and women alike, Scripture models love as sacrificial and intentional. Ephesians calls husbands to love their wives as Christ loves the church, offering a picture of selflessness and devotion. Looking for these traits in a partner, or striving to embody them yourself, aligns your relationship with God's perfect design.

As you reflect, consider if the person you desire shares your commitment to Christ and demonstrates godly character. Prioritizing this will protect your union and nurture a spiritually vibrant marriage.
