# Devotional: Protecting Your Heart in Online Dating

Online dating exposes your heart to many unknowns. Proverbs 4:23 emphasizes the importance of guarding your heart because it affects everything you do and who you become. As a Christian woman, protecting your emotional and spiritual well-being is vital to honor God in your search for love.

**This includes setting healthy boundaries and maintaining purity in your interactions.** 1 Timothy 4:12 encourages you to be an example in love and purity, even in spaces that may tempt you to compromise.

- *Philippians 2:3 – "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves."*
