#### Your Verse

James 1:5 – "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."

#### Devotional: Ask God for Wisdom to Endure Trials

When legal setbacks challenge your faith, your first response may be confusion or despair. But the Bible invites us to seek wisdom directly from God, especially in trying times. *James 1:5* offers a powerful promise: God generously gives wisdom to those who ask. This wisdom helps us discern how to act, respond, and endure setbacks with peace.

#### Prayer for Today

- Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you."







#### Devotional: Submit Your Ways; Trust God Fully

Legal setbacks often bring uncertainty and confusion. We want clear answers immediately, but God calls us instead to full trust—trust that extends beyond what we can understand. In **Proverbs 3:5–6**, God's word reminds us to submit all our ways to Him, not leaning on our own understanding, which is often limited.

This submission doesn't mean passive waiting; it's purposeful trust that God's plan is good, even when our legal hopes are delayed or denied. Psalm 37 encourages us to commit our way to the Lord. By doing so, we free ourselves from the heavy burden of trying to control outcomes and place our confidence in God's eternal wisdom.

Today, reflect on where you struggle to surrender control and ask God to help you trust Him fully with your legal situation.

Day 3: ① Strengthening Spiritual Endurance

#### Devotional: Suffering Builds Perseverance and Hope

**Legal battles can feel like a long, exhausting race.** Yet Paul teaches us in Romans 5 that suffering has a purpose—it produces perseverance, which molds our character and ultimately fills us with hope.

This spiritual endurance is essential when setbacks tempt us toward discouragement or bitterness. Like a soldier enduring hardship or a runner pressing through fatigue, we must fix our eyes on the goal God has for us.

Rather than avoiding suffering, embrace it as an instrument the Lord uses to deepen your faith and strengthen your hope. Every delay or loss becomes a stepping stone to greater spiritual maturity.

#### Supporting Scriptures

- John 14:27 "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you."
- Psalm 34:18 "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted."







Day 4: W Peace in the Midst of Disappointment

#### Devotional: Receive God's Peace Through Prayer

**Legal disappointment often breeds anxiety and unrest.** Yet Scripture guides us to combat anxiety through prayer combined with thanksgiving. Philippians 4 reminds us that God's peace transcends all human understanding and can guard our hearts and minds.

When our legal hopes are crushed, we are invited to approach God with open hands — bringing both our concerns and gratitude. This counterintuitive act infuses us with peace that no court ruling or verdict can take away.

Remember Jesus' promise of peace and God's nearness when brokenhearted. Even when outcomes hurt, we can rest in His presence.

#### Devotional: Let Scripture Guide Your Path

The Bible serves as our guiding light, especially when the path feels uncertain and legal decisions weigh heavily. Psalm 119 emphasizes the illuminating power of God's word — like a lamp lighting our steps in dark places.

God's Word offers wisdom, comfort, and instruction for the complex emotions we face. Through regular reading and meditation, we can hear God's voice speaking courage and direction.

When legal setbacks threaten to cause despair or confusion, anchor yourself in Scripture. Let it remind you that God is present, empowering you to face any challenge with strength.

Day 6: F Growing Patience and Hope

#### Devotional: Cultivate Joyful Hope and Patience

Enduring legal setbacks requires patience—a grace developed by relying on hope and persistent prayer. Paul's exhortation in **Romans 12:12** encourages us to "be joyful in hope" even as we are patient through affliction.

This kind of patience is not a passive resignation but an active, hopeful endurance. It means continuing to pray without ceasing and holding onto the joyful expectation that God's timing is perfect.

When the legal process drags on or outcomes seem unfair, let your spirit be nourished by this hope and patience. God's promises remind us He is good to those who wait and do not lose heart.
