Devotional: Protect Your Heart from the Trap of Greed

Greed is a subtle snare threatening our stewardship of wealth. Jesus warns us clearly to watch for it, reminding us that life's essence is not measured by what we own.

Greed corrupts the soul and distracts us from God's purposes. When our focus shifts to accumulating possessions, we risk losing the joy and freedom God intends for His children.

Paul's words to Timothy emphasize that loving money, rather than God, can lead us away from faith and into ruin. The desire to have more can never truly be satisfied, leaving hearts restless and empty.

Today, examine your heart. Are there areas where greed influences your decisions? Ask God to reveal these hidden places and to help you cultivate contentment and generosity as antidotes.
