#### Devotional: Seek Peace-loving Wisdom Above All Else

**Wisdom** from God is unlike worldly wisdom. It is characterized by purity, peace-loving nature, and mercy. When facing a legal battle or conflict, God's wisdom calls us to seek peace and fairness rather than winning at any cost. It invites us to submit our understanding and trust God completely.

#### Devotional: Faithfully Wait for God's Perfect Justice

**Waiting** is often the hardest part of any conflict. We want swift resolutions, especially when justice seems delayed or denied. Yet God calls us to *be still* before Him and wait patiently for His timing.

Impatience can lead us to take matters into our own hands—escalating conflicts or pushing legal disputes beyond what is wise. But patience is an act of faith that God is working even when we cannot see it. It requires humility and trust to resist the urge for immediate revenge or control.

Today, focus on cultivating patience by resting in God's sovereignty. Remember that He sets the perfect time for every decision and outcome. Waiting is not passive but an active surrender to His justice and peace.

#### Devotional: Rest in God's Perfect and Faithful Justice

**God's justice is perfect and unwavering.** Although legal battles may seem like the place to claim justice, sometimes human systems are flawed, delayed, or painful. Yet God promises righteous judgment and faithful care.

Walking away from a legal dispute can be an act of trusting in God's ultimate justice. It means relinquishing the desire to control outcomes and resting in His perfect character. By choosing peace when possible and avoiding unnecessary retaliation, we align ourselves with God's righteousness.

Remember, faith means sometimes stepping back and leaving judgment in God's hands, confident that He never fails to uphold truth and justice.

#### Devotional: Choose Humility Over Personal Victory
